Next year our meeting is Thursday, October 17 at Immanuel with Darrin Reynolds, Doctrinal message and Jason Harlin, Missional message.

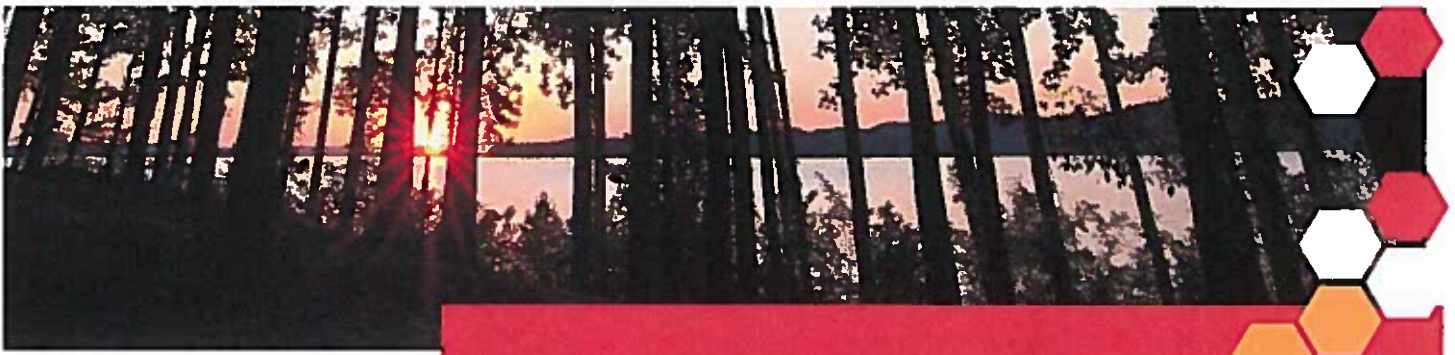
### **SPECIAL CALLED EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING**
